MOBILE ANIMAL SPAY HOSPITAL COMES TO BALCH SPRINGS Spay Neuter Network brings affordable spay/neuter and vaccination services to Balch Springs residents in April.

Balch Springs –March 11, 2014 –Spay Neuter Network (SNN) and the City of Balch Springs are working together to bring affordable spay/neuter and healthcare to dogs and cats living in the City. The first trip to Balch Springs will be on **Wednesday, April 30**, owners must schedule pets for surgery by calling 972-472-3500, limited spaces are available. Walk up vaccinations will also be offered at a reduced cost from 10:00 am – 12:00 noon. The surgeries will be performed on the Hope Mobile, a 45 foot mobile spay/neuter vehicle which will park at the City of Balch Springs Animal Shelter. The deadline to sign up is **Tuesday, April 1, 2014**.

The program will offer low-cost surgery packages to residents living in Balch Springs. Prices range from \$30 for male cats to \$80 for large female dogs. The program goals are to reduce the City of Balch Springs shelter intake and be sure that people can vaccinate their pets against the deadly rabies virus.

“We are excited about working together with local businesses, residents and the City on this new program. We hope to prove that a strong sterilization program will decrease intake and euthanasia numbers at the shelter,” said Bonnie Hill, the SNN President. “In the long run, we hope to show North Texas cities that spending money on prevention is far better than the alternative.”

SNN is a non-profit, 501c3 organization that has provided affordable pet sterilization surgeries and vaccinations because of support from Foundations and donors, for over 8 years, performing more than 120,000 surgeries.
