



BACK TO SCHOOL - FOOD ASSISTANCE -

Applications for food assistance will be accepted from student households.

The American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), enacted on March 11, 2021, provided monies under the Coronavirus State & Local Fiscal Recovery Fund for economic support to communities

The City of Balch Springs targets students. This food program intends to provide food vouchers as economic support to households with students in grades K-12, those who may be facing food shortages and hardships stemming from the ongoing COVID-19 public health emergency. **Applicants must reside in Balch Springs, Texas to apply.** Assistance for food will be provided at a one-time maximum amount of \$200 per household.

Assistance is offered on a first-come, first-serve basis for all complete applications. An application does not guarantee approval. Incomplete applications and missing documentation will be cause for **IMMEDIATE DENIAL AND WILL NOT BE PROCESSED**. Applications are accepted online until funds have been exhausted. The City of Balch Springs reserves the right to close the application portal early.
